

APEHANGER INSTALLATION

- 1. Remove and re-install your handlebars according to your authorized factory manual, noting the following.
- 2. Make sure all cables, wiring, and brake lines are the proper length and routed correctly for your new Burly Brand handlebars. Wider and/or taller handlebars will likely require longer cables, wiring, and brake lines.
- 3. For Non-DCT models only: The aluminum sleeve that is provided is used to mount the clutch perch clamp. DCT models will not use this aluminum sleeve.



- 4. Once new handlebars and all controls are mounted, and all fasteners are tightened to the proper torque specifications (per factory manual), make sure there is no binding or interference while turning your handlebars full left to full right (lock to lock).
- 5. As with most modifications to your motorcycle, handling and general "feel" will be affected. This is especially true when changing the design of the handlebars. Take the time to safely become accustomed to the new handling characteristics of your motorcycle.
