

- 1. Remove the heal guard above the footpeg.




2. Remove the cotter pin, joint pin, thin washer and spring.



3. Transfer the spring to the Burly foot peg, pay close attention to the orientation of the spring. Place the peg between the clevis, insert the joint pin. Place the thin washer on the end and install the cotter pin, bend the cotter pin to prevent it from backing out.



4. Verify the footpeg can move up and down and springs back to its neutral position.



5. Reinstall your heal guard.



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

HONDA REBEL PASSENGER FOOTPEG INSTALLATION

1. Remove the cotter pin, thin washer, joint pin, detent plate, spring and ball.



2. Trasnfer the spring, ball and detent plate to the Burly peg. Insert the assembly into the clevis. Insert the joint pin and thin washer then install the cotter pin, bend the cotter pin to prevent it from backing out.



3. Verify the footpeg can move up and down and the detent system is working properly.

PEG CLOCKING AND TORQUE

- 1. Do not tighten the countersunk bolt until the desired foot peg orientation is found.
- 2. Apply high strength thread locking compound and torque to 25 ft-lbs after the desired position is found.



If you need to change the orientation on the pegs be sure to reapply high strength thread locking compound and retorque to 25 ft-lbs
